- *Communicate in writing quarterly with the heifer donor and the NASDA Junior Committee Chairman on the progress of your project.
- *Maintain complete records on the animal's care and breeding.
- *Feed, care for, house, breed and show the heifer for one year under the guidance of the donor of the heifer and NASDA Junior Committee Chairman.
- *Be 14-20 years-of-age.
- *Become or be a member of the North American South Devon Junior Association.
- *Return to the 2016 National South Devon Show in Denver, Colorado to share the experience and compete in the junior and open show or submit a letter to the donor and NASDA Junior Committee describing why you cannot attend.
- *Semen will be provided for the animal.
