- *Maintain complete records on the animal's care and breeding.
- *Feed, care for, house, breed and show the heifer for one year under the guidance of the donor of the heifer and NASDA Junior Committee Chairman.
- *Be 14-20 years-of-age.
- *Become or be a member of the North American South Devon Junior Association.
- *Participate in one of the following events to share the experience and compete in the junior and/or open show, or submit a letter to the donor and NASDA Junior Committee describing why you cannot attend.
